English Writing This half term we will be focusing on two different text types. We will be writing a variety of recounts in the form of diary entries that focus on sounds. We will also be looking into different types of poems and creating our own around different elements and weather. Reading	 Maths This half term will be learning about decimals and money. We will: Compare numbers with the same decimal points up to hundredths. Round decimals in tenths to the nearest while number. Recognise and write decimal equivelents of quarters and halves. Convert money between pounds and pence.
We will be reading the text Max and the Millions. We will also look at other fictional and non-fictional texts including poems.	 Compare, estimate and calculate with money. Build problem solving skills within measuring and money involving fractions and decimals.

<u>Topic</u>

Our cooking topic this term will focus on building skills to measure liquids and ingredients out. We will be making a pasta bake and falafels. Pupils will focus on building their skills in cutting, peeling and grating foods. In science we are moving onto understanding sound. We will look at how sounds are made along with the patterns between the pitch of the sound and the object that makes them. We will also explore how sound travels through solids, liquids and gasses. Our investigation this term will look to explore which materials are easier for sound to travel through and why.

PEOur focus for outdoor PE is Football. Pupils willlearn skills such as:Pass, stop and control the ballDribble the ballDefending and shooting the ballThis will be UAE's second term swimming.	Art/DT This half term we will explore how to create different musical instruments out of junk. In this topic we will practice our measuring skills, to the nearest millimetre or centemetre and discover different ways to join a variety of materials.
