- South Pole: Penguins live here .



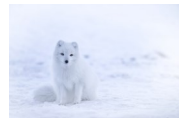

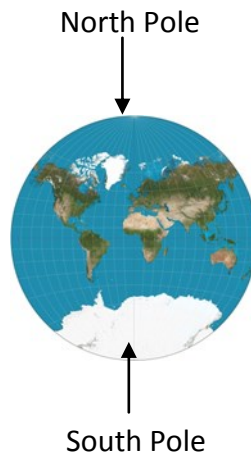
- North Pole : Polar bears and Arctic foxes live here.

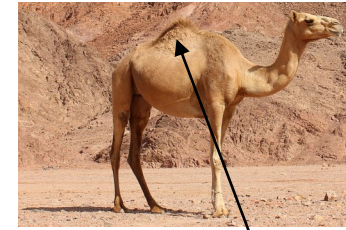
- Together the North Pole and the South Pole are called the polar regions.
