**Re: After school swimming club**

Following the successful trial of an after school swimming club at Shipley Swimming Pool, we are delighted to say that we are continuing with this.

This will be open to Y4 children only. As we have to work with the swimming pool the club will be on a Friday after school. We will be using the school minibus to drive to the pool. Once there, the children will get changed in the individual cubicles and access the swimming pool. This is not a taught lesson. It is an open session so there will be other members of the public there. Life guards will be on duty and our own staff will be present.

Children will need to bring a suitable swimming costume (the pool will not accept t-shirts unless they are neoprene and fitted), boys need to wear swimming shorts that have a suitable draw string waist. They will also need a towel. If they'd like to bring fruit as a snack for afterwards this is permitted.

At 5pm we will set off back to school. We hope to get back by 5.20pm at the latest.

The normal cost of the session would be £2.45 (each week), but we will cover the costs through the Sports Premium Grant. There are only 14 places available and these will be given out on a first come basis.
