Our amazing Y6 have been working really hard since returning from the Easter break; we are really proud of their attitude and resilience and hope that you are too!

Since entering Upper Key Stage 2 your child has missed out on lots of experiences that help them to make long lasting positive memories as well as learning opportunities due to Covid restrictions.

In line with the Government roadmap, we expect to be able to hold residentials from the 17th May, but this may well change.
