This half term, we will be learning about Spring Stories and Celebrations, including Ramadan, Mother's Day and Easter, and exploring how different families celebrate special times. We will also focus on being healthy, learning about healthy foods and how exercise helps our bodies grow strong. Our learning will be supported through stories, including Mr Wolf's Pancakes, Rashad's Ramadan, My Mummy is Magic and We're going on an Egg hunt.

### Personal Social Emotional Development

We will learn about being healthy by cooking and baking healthy foods, taking part in daily exercise and talking about how our bodies change when we are active. Children will practice sharing, turn taking and working together.

### Communication, Language and Literacy

Children will use talk to explain ideas, recall experiences and predict what might happen next. We will ask and answer who, what and where questions, retell simple events and follow 2-part instructions.

### Mathematics

Children will practice counting, recognising numbers, exploring shapes, patterns and measures. and using everyday activities

### Understanding the World

We explore forces by experimenting with pushing and pulling. Children will learn about Ramadan, Mother's Day and Easter and talk about how people celebrate special times in different ways.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Children will develop their painting and creative skills, creating artwork inspired by spring, celebrations and stories.
