Our topic is '**Marvellous Me**'. We will be learning all about ourselves, our families and each other. We will be learning about our emotions and how we are feeling.

Personal Social Emotional Development

Our focus this term will be getting to know each other and making new relationships with our teachers and peers. We will learn about our emotions and how we are feeling. We will be supporting this learning with the story 'Colour Monster'.

We will also be exploring about the different factors that support our health and well-being, such as healthy eating, personal hygiene and regular physical activity.

Communication, Language and Literacy

During this term we will encourage children to use full sentences when talking. We will be exploring how to express our ideas and feelings about experiences and emotions.

We will focus on understanding how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

We will begin to access our DI reading and language programme; children will bring home sheets to read and review at home with support.

Mathematics

We will begin to understand matching, sorting and comparing numbers and objects within 5.

Understanding the World

This term we will be looking at ourselves, our families and linking these familiarities to past and present. We will be going on a local walk to explore the local area and recreate maps.

Expressive Arts and Design

As our topic is 'Marvellous Me' we will be creating self-portraits and portraits of our families. Children will have access to a variety of materials and media to create with.
