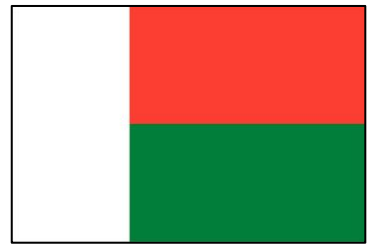




Y2 Curriculum News Summer 1



English

This half term, we will be looking at the story of 'The Rainbow Fish' and write a Letter of apology inspired by a story that conveys a moral.

SPaG focus includes:

- Consolidation of previous learning.
- Apostrophes to mark missing letters and singular possession in nouns

Maths

This half term, children will be looking at fractions.

- Recognise parts, wholes, equal and unequal parts.
- Recognise, find, name, and write fractions $1/2$, $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$ and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- Understand unit and non-unit fractions.
- Write simple fractions for example, $1/2$ of $6 = 3$ and recognise the equivalence of $2/4$ and $1/2$.

Topic

Our topic this half term is **Floating and Sinking**, which is science based. We will be identifying and comparing suitability of everyday materials for particular uses. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed. We will also explore how objects float or sink depending on their density.

PE Indoor - Gymnastics

- Perform shapes, jumps, tucks with a strong body and control.
- Perform a sequence on apparatus

Outdoor - Athletics

- Using arms and keeping head still when exploring running patterns
- Throw in correct stance 'Usain Bolt position' Use arms to improve jumping.

We will continue to investigate tone by drawing light/dark lines, light/dark patterns, and light/dark shapes using a pencil.
