


Y2 Curriculum News Autumn 2



English

This half term, we will be looking at writing a diary entry.

We will be focussing on:

- Using capital letters at the start of the sentence and full stops of the end of the sentence
- Writing exclamations and questions
- Conjunctions and/because/but/so
- · Writing in the past tense
- Sequencing events in order

We will have daily DI lessons. Look out for our DI worksheets/books in their bag. We will also be focussing on cursive handwriting.

Maths

This half term, children will be looking at addition and subtraction.

We will be focusing on:

- Bonds to 10 and 100.
- Fact Families and related facts.
- Adding and subtracting ls.
- Adding three I-digit numbers
- Adding to the next 10/across a 10.
- Subtract across 10 and subtract from a 10.
- Add and subtract 2-digit numbers.

Topic

Our topic this half term is The Great Fire of London. In History, we will learn about the sequence and why the fire spread so quickly. We will also look at the UK in geography and learn about London and the River Thames. Additionally, we will be comparing the Great Fire of London with the Bradford City Fire.

PE

Indoor -Gymnastics

Children will perform a sequence on apparatus (roll, jump, balance) and moving on and off with strong body control.

Outdoor - Ball Skills

We will continue developing our ball skills in order to participate in ball games.

Art/DT

Our focus in DT is structures, where we will be designing and making a Tutor house. The children will use their existing knowledge as well as learning how to measure, mark out and cut materials to create their finished piece.
