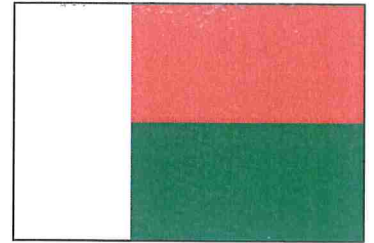




Y2 Curriculum News Spring 2



English

This half term, we will be looking at the story of 'The Rainbow Fish' and write a descriptive narrative inspired by a story that conveys a moral lesson.

SPaG focus includes:

- Using expanded noun phrases for description
- Using the co-ordination 'but' and the subordination 'when' to expand a sentence
- Using the suffixes 'ful', 'less' and 'ly' to add description
- Using questions and exclamations for expression

Maths

This half term, children will be looking at money and multiplication and division.

Money -

We will be focusing on:

- Calculating and comparing amounts, making a pound and finding change.

Multiplication and division -

We will be focussing on:

- Becoming fluent in the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.
- Recognising odd and even numbers and how to make arrays and equal groups.

Topic

Our topic this half term is Living things and their habitats, which is science based. We will be identifying the differences between things which are alive, dead or have never lived. We will also explore how plants and animals are suited to their habitats, while using food chains to describe the relationships between them.

PE

Indoor - Dance

- Performing movements with control and expression.
- Remembering simple steps

Outdoor - Tag Rugby

- Learning tactics for attacking and defending.
- Developing skills for passing and dodging effectively.

Art/DT

Textiles (DT) -

- Understanding how to cut, shape and join fabric to make a simple product.
- Beginning to use basic sewing techniques.
