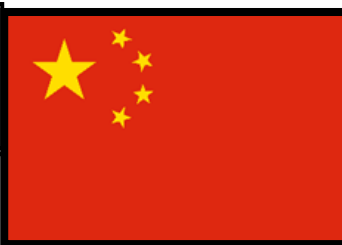
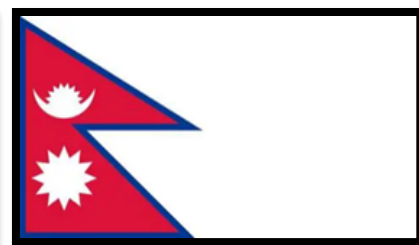


Year 3- Summer 1

Art/DT: In art year 3 will begin their study on Monet with paints looking at primary and secondary colours and making their own version of one of his famous paintings.

Maths: Year 3 will be looking at a variety of Fractions including unit and non-unit- fractions as well as practicing the skill of adding and subtracting them. Ending the topic with some reasoning with Fractions of an amount. They will then move onto money looking at pounds and pence. And how to add and subtract/find change of an amount.

Topic:

During this half term in topic, we will have a geography focus doing Europe and Rivers. We will be looking at the countries, seas, mountains and rivers in Europe. We will then further focus in on what rivers are and the different parts of a river.



Pe:

In Pe this half term year 3 will be looking at athletics. Thinking about running, throwing and jumping. This is helping the children to improve: balance, co-ordination, power, speed, flexibility and agility. The key knowledge they will understand is: How to accelerate from standing still to running, standing long jump, standing triple jump and shot put.

English:

Reading: We have started the wind and the willows, and the children will be reading and exploring the different features of the text and helping expose the children to less familiar vocabulary. We will then move onto looking at a poem called Grandma and the sea.

Writing: In writing the children are currently looking at dream memories. This will then lead to the children starting to make up their own dream memory thinking about setting, object description, reaction, tension in their memory, creatures and an ending.
